Dear Village Citizens:

The Village of Clemmons is pleased to offer a Leaf/Limb/Grass Pickup Program to all residents. Burning of yard waste will no longer be allowed.

**LEAF/LIMB/GRASS SCHEDULE
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015 - 2016**

ALL PICKUPS MUST BE PLACED AT THE EDGE OF YOUR PROPERTY, BUT NOT IN THE STREET AND AWAY FROM FENCES, MAILBOXES AND POWER LINES BY 7:00 A.M. ON MONDAY MORNING OF YOUR SCHEDULED WEEK. THE MONTHLY SCHEDULE BEGINS WITH THE FIRST MONDAY OF THE MONTH.

LIMB COLLECTION – March thru November

Area “B” – West of Lewisville-Clemmons Road and Middlebrook Drive (Tanglewood Park side) – 1st week of the month

Area “A” – East of Lewisville-Clemmons Road and Middlebrook Drive (Winston-Salem side) – 2nd week of the month

GRASS AND LEAF COLLECTION – April thru November:

Area “A” – East of Lewisville-Clemmons Road and Middlebrook Drive (Winston-Salem side) – 1st and 3rd week of the month

Area “B” – West of Lewisville-Clemmons Road and Middlebrook Drive (Tanglewood Park side) – 2nd and 4th week of the month

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION – 1st two (2) weeks of January only.

Please remember that we cannot predict the exact day or time for pickup on a particular street. Have your leaves, limbs, or grass to the edge of the street by 7:00 A.M. on Monday morning of the scheduled week. Schedules may change due to seasonal weather conditions or emergency work. LIMB PICKUP GUIDELINES

Limbs should be placed at the edge of your property, but not in the street, by 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning of the scheduled week of pickup. If limbs are put out after that time and the pickup has already been made on your street, you will have to wait until the next scheduled pickup for them to be removed.

Limbs should be **stacked in one pile** with the large end toward the edge of the street, **not randomly pitched**. Small piles of brush must be bundled and tied with string or twine. Loose twig piles will not be picked up.

Limbs should be reasonably fresh and solid. No stacks of rotten wood. Hedge trimmings will be acceptable if put on top of the pile. Limbs should not be larger than 6” in diameter and no longer than 16 feet.

Any foreign objects such as rocks, metal, or building materials contaminate the pile and will keep the pile from being picked up.

LEAF AND GRASS PICKUP GUIDELINES

Leaves and grass should be placed at the edge of your property, but **not in the street**, by 7:00 a.m. on Monday morning of the scheduled week of pickup. If leaves and grass are put out after that time and the pickup has already been made on your street, you will have to wait until the next scheduled pickup for them to be removed.

Leaves and grass must be in a wind row no wider than 5 feet for equipment to vacuum up quickly. Do not bag leaves or grass.

Absolutely no twigs, sticks, garden trimmings, tomato vines, corn stalks, flowers or shrubs should be in the leaves or grass.

If improperly placed or contaminated with other debris, the leaves and grass will not be picked up.
