

**SPECIAL MEETING OF  
THE VILLAGE OF CLEMMONS COUNCIL  
OCTOBER 21, 2014**

The Village of Clemmons Council met on Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at 2 p.m. The meeting was held at the Village Hall, Clemmons, North Carolina. The following members were present: Mayor Nelson and Council Members Cameron, Denny, Lawry, Roark and Rogers. No Council member was absent. Also present was NCDOT Secretary Anthony Tata, NCDOT Division Engineer Patrick Ivey and NC Representative Donny Lambeth.

**Call to Order**

Mayor Nelson called the meeting to order at 2 p.m.

**Welcome and Introduction**

Mayor Nelson introduced guests and welcomed everyone to the meeting..

**Business**

Mayor Nelson announced that any public comments received during the next regular Council meeting will be forwarded to Secretary Tata's office. Manager Looper was called on to provide a brief history summary of both the Idols Road Extension and Lewisville-Clemmons Road TIP projects. Mr. Ivey concurred with the summary provided.

Secretary Tata provided information on his department's efforts to prioritize transportation projects throughout the state based on congestion, travel time, safety, economic development and connectivity. He and Mr. Ivey anticipates the Idols Road Extension project, a new two-lane section between Hampton Road and US Hwy 158, will be on the STIP list. Available funds will determine where a line will be drawn for funded projects.

The purpose of the feasibility study for Lewisville-Clemmons Road was to address safety and service issues. Mr. Ivey stated a reduction of left turns would improve issues on this road. Absent a median, left turns could be reduced by eliminating driveway cuts and promoting connectivity. He added he had no authority to close driveways cuts. It is the authority of the Council working through development standards. Council informed him of the Lewisville-Clemmons Road Overlay Committee to address issues in this area including driveway cuts. Mr. Ivey's office was invited to meet with the committee.

**Adjournment**

Council Member Rogers moved to adjourn the meeting at 3:17 p.m. The motion was seconded by Council Member Roark and unanimously approved.
