

Tanglewood Park Farmers Market

Rules and Regulations

Hours of Operation: 8:30 AM – 12:00 PM Saturday
4:00 PM – 6:00 PM Thursday
April 18, 2015 – October 31, 2015

Products Sold: All products sold at the Market must be grown or agriculturally related and made of farm products by the person or family selling the product. Only homegrown or homemade products from the following counties may be sold: Forsyth, Surry, Stokes, Rockingham, Guilford, Davidson, Davie, and Yadkin. Vendors from other counties may be considered on a case-by-case basis. No buying and reselling of product or other products is allowed.

Permitted Products:

- A. Any vegetable grown by the seller from seeds, sets, or seedlings.
- B. Any fruits, nuts, or berries grown by the seller from trees, bushes, or vines on the seller's property.
- C. Any plant grown by the seller from seed, seedling, transplant, or cuttings.
- D. Bulbs propagated by the seller.
- E. Eggs produced by the seller's poultry.
- F. Honey produced by the seller's bees.
- G. Cut, dried flowers or natural items grown by the seller.
- H. Preserves, pickles, relishes, jams, and jellies made by the seller. No other canned foods such as green beans, tomatoes, corn, peas, carrots, etc. may be sold.
- I. Baked goods: Baked goods must follow all county and state laws applicable to such sales and shall verify that they will comply when submitting their application, including, but not limited to, North Carolina Department of Agriculture (NCDA) and local health department regulations.
- J. Sustainable livestock, limited to:
 1. Poultry
 - Pasture raised on seller's property.
 - Slaughtered and processed in accordance with the consumer safety regulations of the USDA and NCDA.
 - Hormone and antibiotic free.
 - Sanitation, transportation, handling, and storage of the meat for sale must be done in a manner compliant with all applicable county, state, and federal health and safety regulations.
 - Sellers must be registered Meat and Poultry Handlers.
 2. Beef and Lamb
 - Pasture raised on seller's property.
 - Grass fed throughout its lifecycle in accordance with the requirements of the USDA.
 - Hormone and antibiotic free.
 - Slaughtered and processed in accordance with the consumer safety regulations of the USDA and NCDA.
 - Sanitation, transportation, handling, and storage of the meat for sale must be done in a manner compliant with all applicable county, state, and federal health and safety regulations.
 - Sellers must be registered Meat and Poultry Handlers.

Fees and Charges: Annual Fees: \$150 – Assigned space for entire season
\$100 – Saturdays only
\$50 – Weekdays only

Daily Fee: Space available – First come, first serve
\$5 – Weekday \$10 – Saturday

Assignment of Space: Assignment will be made by the Farmers Market Coordinate on-site. If multiple vendors are applying to sell the same items of the same quality, preference will be given first to vendors residing in the Forsyth County limits and then according to vendor proximity to the Forsyth County area. Tanglewood Farmers Market is located near the Tanglewood Dog Park and Tanglewood Campground. No gate entry fees are required for the vendors or the general public to attend the Tanglewood Farmers Market since it is located prior to the park's entrance.

Set-up Time: All vendors must be set up and ready for business fifteen (15) minutes prior to opening time for the Market or their space may be assigned to another vendor unless prior arrangements have been made with the Farmers Market Coordinator.

Signage: All vendors must display a sign with their name and address (city). Proper representation of products, origination, and product practices by the vendor must be used.

Product Liability: All food items must meet state and local health regulations. All produce must be top quality. Vendors are highly encouraged to have liability insurance for the products they sell. As stated in the applications, Forsyth County and the Village of Clemmons is not liable for anything sold by any vendor.

Weights and Measures: All vendors must comply with the North Carolina Statutes governing the weight and measurement of produce and other items sold. All scales must be approved as "Legal for Trade". Anyone using scales must have them certified by the NCDA. For certification of a scale, contact the NCDA Standards Division. At the beginning of every season vendors may be subject to weights/scales certification by the NCDA.

Animals: No live animals may be present, sold, or given away at the Market.

Cleanliness: Each vendor is responsible for keeping their assigned space clean during use and when leaving the facility. Excess produce must be removed from the Market and not dumped in Market trash cans.

Vehicular Safety: Vendors should not move their vehicles in or out of the Market area during the times when such movement would pose a danger to people in the shopping area. This includes, but is not limited to, Market hours.

The Tanglewood Park Farmers Market is sponsored by Forsyth County and the Village of Clemmons and operated by Tanglewood Farmers Market Volunteer Group organized by the Village of Clemmons. This Farmers Market Committee is responsible for the routine operation of the Market in accordance with these duly adopted rules and regulations and specifically has the authority to interpret these rules and regulations. Any objections to an interpretation of these rules may be filed in writing with the Advisory Board. The decision of the Advisory Board regarding any such objection is final. Forsyth County and the Village of Clemmons reserve the right to interpret the Market Rules and to modify them as needed for the Market's operation.

I further understand:

1. No alcoholic beverages or drugs are permitted.
2. No pets, other than service animals, are allowed to be brought by vendors.
3. No flea market items may be sold or displayed at any time.
4. All vendor applications must be approved and fees paid to the Tanglewood Park Welcome Center at least one week prior to vendor selling products at the Market. After each vendor pays the fee, they will be given a laminated placard in which they must display to the Farmers Market Coordinator when they arrive on site.
5. All rules are enforced by the Farmers Market Coordinator and the Village of Clemmons.

Hold Harmless Clause and Insurance

All authorized vendors participating in the Tanglewood Park Farmers Market shall be individually and severally responsible to the Forsyth County Parks and Village of Clemmons for any loss, bodily or personal injury, deaths and/or property damage that may occur as a result of the vendor's negligence or that of its servants, agents, and employees. All vendors hereby agree to indemnify and hold Forsyth County and the Village of Clemmons, their officers and employees harmless from any loss, cost, damages, and other expenses, including attorneys' fees, suffered by or incurred by Forsyth County and the Village of Clemmons by reason of the vendor's negligence or that of its servants, agents, and employees. No insurance is provided by Forsyth County or the Village of Clemmons to participants in the Tanglewood Park Farmers Market.
