

YES! RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

PLACE ALL RECYCLABLES TOGETHER IN YOUR CART!



PLASTIC BOTTLES ONLY

- Only bottles with a neck or opening smaller than the widest part.
- Remove caps and discard.
- Rinse, labels are ok.
- NO wide mouth containers (margarine tubs, ice cream pails, etc.)



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- Flatten cardboard boxes
- NO pizza boxes or boxes contaminated with grease or food residue
- For excessive or large items of cardboard, residents of the Village can use the Convenience Site located at Public Works on 3800 Dillon Industrial Dr. across from the SWFL Ball Fields. It is open from 7:00 am - 3:00 pm, Monday thru Friday. Phone: (336) 766-9170



ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS, STEEL FOOD AND BEVERAGE CANS, AND AEROSOL CANS

- Rinse.
- Lids only if still attached and tucked inside; labels are ok.
- Aerosol cans - must be empty - remove and discard caps - do not flatten.



GLASS FOOD AND BEVERAGE JARS/BOTTLES

- Remove caps/lids and discard. Labels are ok.
- Rinse.



NEWSPAPERS and INSERTS

- Remove from plastic bags.



JUNK MAIL AND OFFICE PAPER

- Envelopes, office & notebook paper, etc.
- Shredded office paper must be bagged and tied in a clear plastic bag to prevent litter.



CHIPBOARD/PAPERBOARD (usually brown or gray on the inside)

- Cereal boxes, paper towel rolls, facial tissue boxes, gift boxes, etc.
- Remove plastic and foil liners.



PHONE BOOKS



MAGAZINES and CATALOGS

- NO books, binders or spiral notebooks.



ALUMINUM PIE TINS & FOIL

- Rinse food residue from pie tins.



CARDBOARD MILK & JUICE CARTONS

NO! THESE ARE NOT RECYCLABLE!

Guidelines for rollout recycling

- ❑ The cart can only be used for the recyclable materials listed inside this brochure. No garbage, trash, or yard waste.
- ❑ All recyclables must be placed inside the cart and the lid must be completely closed. Materials left beside the cart will not be collected.
- ❑ Collections will take place at the curb.
- ❑ The front of the cart must face the street (the handle is located on the back side).
- ❑ Only Waste Management issued cart may be used for recyclables collection.
- ❑ Do not pack materials into carts.
- ❑ Leave a minimum of five (5) feet of space between recycling cart, trash cans, mailbox, parked cars, etc.
- ❑ Do not place under low utility lines or tree limbs, in front of cars or mailboxes
- ❑ The cart must be at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day and must be removed from the curb by the next day.
- ❑ Do not write house numbers or place any other markings on the cart. The recycling cart is the property of Waste Management

ADVANTAGES OF ROLLOUT RECYCLING

- ❑ The 96-gallon cart provides more than five times the capacity of the 18-gallon bin.
- ❑ Eliminates the need to separate paper products from plastics, glass, and metals.
- ❑ Cardboard does not have to be broken down as long as it fits completely inside the cart.
- ❑ Increases the amount of recyclable materials collected weekly.
- ❑ Makes storage of recyclables more manageable from week-to-week.
- ❑ Allows the use of automated equipment for collection, thereby reduces collection times and carbon emissions.
- ❑ Saves natural resources; conserves energy; reduces greenhouse gases, pollution, and problems associated with litter.
